Abraham had to travel for three days to get to the place God had chosen. Find the right path through the wilderness and help Abraham reach the mountain.

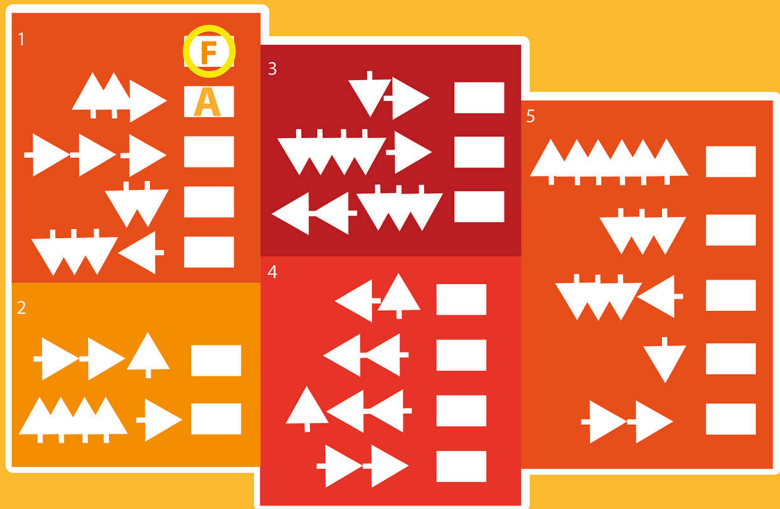

A couple years later, in April, 1950, Brother Branham was overseas, having meetings in Finland.

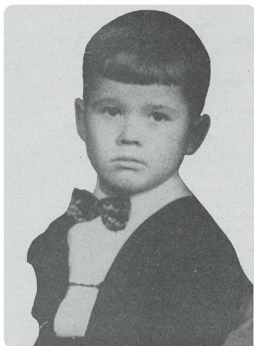
Word had spread throughout the area about "the healer from America." Brother Branham was with some other brothers when they witnessed an awful sight. Two little boys were

hit by a car traveling 60 miles an hour! It was horrible; one of the boys was completely ran over by the car, and tossed up in the air by the tires. He was lying there, mangled and dead. The other boy got hit and tossed away from the car, but he was still alive and on his way to the hospital.

Some of the brothers that were with Brother Branham said he should go and look at the dead boy. Brother Branham was sad, because he knew what happened, but he decided to go see him anyway. When he looked at the boy, something seemed very familiar. Brother Branham asked if this boy had ever

been in a prayer line, but nobody recognized the poor little dead boy.

Just then the Holy Spirit reminded Brother Branham about the vision he had a couple years earlier. Brother Branham noticed the rocky terrain, and it all came to him. This was the boy he saw in the vision!



Brother Branham got really excited and told the other brothers to look at what they had written in their Bibles. Then they saw it: a rocky country, a young boy with brown hair and brown eyes that is poorly dressed; this was it!

The vision Brother Branham saw years earlier was coming to pass right before their eyes!

Brother Branham had heard from the Lord, and he was taking Him at His Word. There was no stopping it now. Brother Branham prayed for the boy and the Lord did the rest. The young boy jumped up, perfectly well and normal!

Dead Raised to Life

On one way down from a mountain we witnessed a sickening sight. A car just in front of us ran over two little school boys about 10 or 11 years old, knocking them down and dead. The car left the road, stopped, our car and looked upon the two terrible scenes. Both boys appeared to be dead. We hurried to pick up one and another car carried the other. As we left the scene, I heard the lifeline and saw that when Bro. Branham and Sister Isaacson were sitting, I knew that it was too late to help. . . his pulse was gone. Brother said, "The little child drove on towards us. His pulse is beating and voices in prayer, and after a bit we heard Bro. Branham say, "His pulse is beating again." . . .

The Lord showed Bro. Branham in a vision that the child would recover also. . . . And I distinctly remembered the vision he told us about in Miami, Fla., of a little boy being raised from the dead. He hadn't known when or where it would be, but he began to hear from the Lord. . . . By the time we reached the hospital, the little fellow had regained consciousness and was crying. He was soon sent home, and the other boy is well on the way to recovery. Bro. Branham had a vision about him and not many would live.

Space in Building Rained

Concerning the meetings, we have never seen it on this way. Such moving scenes! The people here from beyond the Arctic Circle, from borders of Red Russia, The building is full, besides a vast crowd sent to the building. (Think of a foot and mile from Arctic Circle.) The streets are full, hundreds standing everywhere for hours. Space inside is rationed by means of cards that allow the person only one while to stand in the streets of Jerusalem. We still have that vast stream of suffering humanity in the streets of Jerusalem, the same (mortal) with compassion when he saw the multitudes.) It is only our faith that is different. But here we saw more faith than I could say. . . . The crowd sent up for prayer when altar calls are made that we have ever seen. . . . God has many poor axioms here in this north land. After spending a little time in Paris and coming here, I told the group in what was coming out of a dark rathole man in a dark white in the sunlight. What a difference where Rome rules and where people are in a dark hank. We wish some days that all of you could be here

We are on our way to meet Ken Ensign for home and the U. S. A. We have had a wonderful trip, and the people everywhere have been kind to us. I wish to express to our friends at home that our dear Lord Jesus has been good to us and given us victory in practically every case of sickness or affliction I have encountered. Oh how I love Him, and I want to thank our dear Christian friends and fellow citizens of the Kingdom of His dear Son, for your faithful prayers which have meant so much to us. Brother Baxter, Brother Lindsay, Brother Moore, and Howard and I are very grateful to you all. If our Lord Jesus is willing, we are returning to you soon and in verse again in His lovely Newsmagazine in a great test meeting at Chicago during the latter part of June. I am your Brother in Christian Service, William Branham

Communist Opposition

Tuesday night in Helsinki . . . We returned yesterday morning from Kappela to the Communist Party of 400 thousand people. At the evening service tonight the building, the hospital, was packed as it has been from the beginning; and outside in the streets were hundreds, perhaps as many as two thousand, waited patiently just to get a glimpse of Bro. Branham as he came out. The whole city is stirred, the papers are writing, some for and some against us. Of interest is the Communist paper . . . It is leading the fight. Of course, we are not anxious to stir them up by fighting back, as we are only ten miles from the Iron Curtain, and you could appreciate your country more if you stayed here while we were in the streets of Jerusalem. We are plagued with nerves and heart trouble, the strain under which to me today would tell a very sad story. . . . She just happened to be able to speak English; I think there would be many far worse if we were able to understand this language. To see this thing, would be able to see, being able at the same time to see a Living Redeemer would be too big a thing to see. My time and space are gone so most say farewell to everyone. I am thinking of SEPTEMBER 1950

The following article is gleaned from a letter written by a member of the Branham Party, Jack Moore, to the church of which he is pastor, Ika Tahvanala, Miesopoli, Louisiana.

"The most welcome visitor of all here is the sun. Existence would be impossible but for it, for we are lost in the dark unless from the Arctic Circle. All would be a frozen mass of desolation and death but for the sun. Here, as elsewhere, the stream of crippled, sick and blind flow on to eternity. It is truly a sight to watch such even a Son whose healing hands touch even a Son who God. My heart cries "oh how have we failed, for if I allow but our love on me today, for if I allow but our love in freedom and our feeling for Him and His people engaged in indifference. I spoke first in morning service and Bro. Lindsay followed. The Spirit led us; then we prayed for some and God met us. In the afternoon, Bro. Branham, Bro. Lindsay and I and Sister Jacobson, our interpreter, in company with a group of pastors, went on a hill near the city where there is a lookout tower from which we saw the chain of beautiful lakes and countryside, all frozen over. The city of Kuopio has a population of 40,000. The Finnish man-bombard that this city in the dead of winter during the war. People of little Finland have suffered much, but they give God glory for their freedom which they now enjoy. On the tower our friends began to sing some of the songs of their worship. One in particular about Golgotha was so moving that some strangers that were sitting the tower became visibly moved and asked that they sing more. We were all greatly moved and felt the presence and presence of the Holy Spirit as that hill far away.

delicious buttery yellow cake things

How to make delicious buttery yellow cake things that are so good we couldn't even keep them long enough to take a picture of them for this magazine so you could see what they look like and make them for yourself. {GASP} We don't even know what they are called because they were so good, we ate the paper the recipe was on. {SLURP}

Ingredients:

1 box of yellow cake mix

1 stick of melted butter

3 eggs

1-8oz block of cream cheese (softened)

16 oz of powdered sugar

- 1) Preheat oven to 325 degrees.
- 2) Mix yellow cake mix, melted butter, and 1 egg together to form a soft dough. Press into the bottom of a 13x9 inch pan.
- 3) Mix together softened cream cheese and 2 eggs with an electric mixer. Add the powdered sugar and mix until the mixture is smooth and creamy. Pour over the first layer already in the pan.
- 4) Bake at 325 degrees for 40-50 minutes or until the top is slightly browned.
- 5) Eat them. (WARNING - do NOT eat the recipe paper. You will need it next time you bake them (like 10 minutes later).

How to make Hedgehog Cookies



Here is a fun recipe! Who knew that hedgehogs would be so delicious?

WHAT YOU NEED

- 1/2 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1/4 cup confectioner's sugar
- 2/3 cup all-purpose flour
- 1/3 cup butter, softened
- 2/3 cup ground pecans
- 1/2 cup 60% cacao chocolate chips
- 1/4 cup chocolate sprinkles
- 1/8 teaspoon salt

- 1) Mix the butter and confectioner's sugar in a bowl, until it is really fluffy. Beat in the vanilla.
- 2) Now, slowly mix in the flour, salt and pecans. Make sure it is mixed up really well.
- 3) Take the dough you made and roll it into small balls - about the size of a golf ball. Pinch one side of it down to form a nose. Place your hedgehogs on a greased baking sheet, about 2 inches apart. Bake at 325 degrees for 12-15 minutes or until lightly browned. Let cool.
- 4) In a microwave, melt the chocolate and stir it until smooth. Spoon the chocolate over the back of the hedgehog, but don't get any on its face (chocolate might make hedgehogs sick.) Place the cookies on waxed paper and immediately coat the wet chocolate with sprinkles.
- 5) Dip a toothpick into the melted chocolate, and make two eyes and a nose. Let cool.
- 6) Use your fingers to get the left over chocolate out of the bowl, and lick it clean. You might have to share with your brother or sister.

Abraham

WHEN ABRAHAM WAS AN OLD MAN, God told him that he would have a son. Even though he knew that he and his wife, Sarah, were too old to have children, he believed God anyway.

God honored Abraham's faith, and made him and Sarah young again. Little Isaac was born. Abraham knew that Isaac was God's special gift, and he loved him very, very much.

Because Jesus had not come to earth yet, God required His people to provide a sacrifice to cover their sins. Godly people like Abraham took innocent animals and killed them as a sacrifice to God.

But Abraham didn't question God; he just obeyed Him. He told young Isaac to come with him up to Mount Moriah. It was a three-day journey, way high up on the mountain. As Abraham and Isaac walked up to the place where Isaac was to be sacrificed, Isaac noticed that something was missing. He looked up at his dad and humbly asked,

"Behold the fire and the wood: but where is the lamb for a burnt offering?"

Abraham answered, "My son, God will provide Himself a lamb for a burnt offering."

Next, Abraham took Isaac and tied him up on the altar. Abraham was ready to kill the son that God had promised him; but Abraham had faith. He knew that if God wanted it, somehow everything would come out just right.

Rule #5

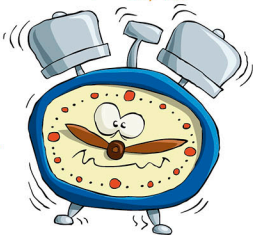
If your dad is cooking pancakes over the campfire, and accidentally starts the forest on fire, a good place to be is at your camping spot. That's where the pancakes will probably be.

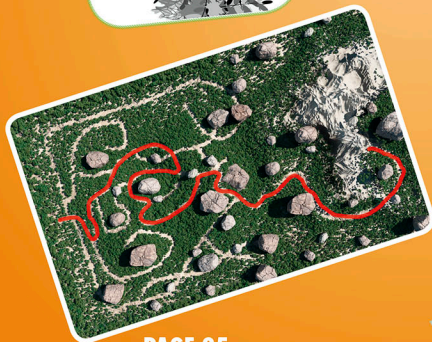
