how to make Cobbler



WHAT YOU NEED:

- 2 (8 oz) cans refrigerated crescent rolls
- 2 large Granny Smith apples - peeled, cored, and cut into 8 wedges each
- 1 cup butter, melted
- 1 1/2 cups white sugar
- 1 tablespoon ground cinnamon
- 1 (12 fluid oz) can or bottle caffeinated citrus-flavored soda (such as Mountain Dew®)

WHAT YOU NEED TO DO:

- 1 Preheat oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C). Grease a 9x13 inch baking dish.
- 2 Unroll the crescent roll dough, and separate the sheets into individual triangles.
- 3 Roll each apple wedge into a triangle of dough, and place them into the baking dish, seam sides down.
- 4 Mix the melted butter, sugar, and cinnamon in a bowl, and spoon evenly over the dough-wrapped apple slices.
- 5 Pour the soda over the rolls.
- 6 Bake in the preheated oven until the top is browned, the apples are cooked through, and the cobbler is bubbling, 45 to 50 minutes.

how to make Popcorn Balls



WHAT YOU NEED:

- 3/4 cup light corn syrup
- 1/4 cup margarine
- 2 teaspoons cold water
- 2 and 5/8 cups confectioners' sugar
- 1 cup marshmallows
- 5 quarts plain popped popcorn

WHAT YOU NEED TO DO:

- 1 In a saucepan over medium heat, combine the corn syrup, margarine, cold water, confectioners' sugar and marshmallows.
- 2 Heat and stir until the mixture comes to a boil.
- 3 Carefully combine the hot mixture with the popcorn, coating each kernel.
- 4 Grease hands with vegetable shortening and quickly shape the coated popcorn into balls before it cools.
- 5 Wrap with cellophane or plastic wrap and store at room temperature.



GUESS THE SCENE

This game is like the famous game "pictionary," but instead of guessing the "thing" you have to guess the Bible scene that your teammate is drawing. Here is how to play: Get at least two teams with at least two people on each team. One team writes down a Bible scene for the other team to draw and gives it to the other team's artist. They get 90 seconds to try to guess what their teammate is drawing. Feel free to change the amount of time you have to guess the scene. Have fun!

Australia holds two world records. It is the world's largest island, and the world's smallest continent.

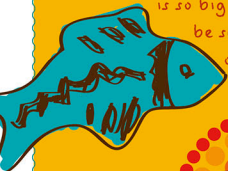

LAZARUS

Even though Jesus was God, He still lived in human flesh;
He was both God and human.

Us humans have friends, we get hungry, sleepy, happy, and sometimes we get sad. Jesus felt all of those things, just like you and me.

One day, Jesus' really good friend, Lazarus, got really sick. He was so sick they thought he was going to die! Lazarus' two sisters, Mary and Martha got really scared, and sent for Jesus right away.

When Jesus heard that Lazarus was sick, He didn't go right to His friend. He stayed right where He was and let His good friend, Lazarus, die. Jesus knew that Lazarus had to die so that He could show the power of God to raise him back up!

Lazarus was also a good friend to the disciples, so they all got really sad when he died. They all

made the short trip to the town of Bethany, where Lazarus was buried.

First, Martha came running to Jesus, then came Mary, her sister. They both knew that if Jesus would have been there, their brother would not have died, but they didn't yet know just how powerful Jesus was!

They brought Jesus to the grave where they had laid Lazarus four days earlier. It was such a sad time that even Jesus cried. Then things started to change. Jesus was about to prove that He was God on earth!



Jesus commanded the people to take away the stone from Lazarus' grave. He straightened His shoulders back and cried out with a loud, powerful Voice, "Lazarus, come forth."

Can you imagine what everyone must have thought when a man who had been dead for four days, got up and walked out of his grave? How could a Man who just finished weeping for His friend speak the Word and bring him back to life? He was God in human flesh proving His power!

The same Jesus Who rose Lazarus from the grave is still here today ready to listen if you ever want to talk to Him. He is your Friend and ready to help you if you ever need Him. The only thing that He asks of you is that you believe in Him, and believe His Word!

DID YOU KNOW?

Jesus had to use the name of "Lazarus" when He said "Lazarus, come forth"? Brother Branham said that if He wouldn't have said that name, every single person would have had to come out of their graves. It would have been the resurrection!



RAISING JAIRUS' Daughter

During the time of Jesus there was a faithful ruler in the synagogue named Jairus. He was a good man, but he was involved with the religious powers of the day. His friends were jealous of Jesus and they hated Him, but there was something inside Jairus that knew better than that.

One day, Jairus' daughter got really, really sick. The doctors tried to help her, but they couldn't. She was going to die. Jairus was devastated, there had

to be something else that he could do. Then he remembered Jesus.

Jairus was so desperate to help his little girl that he ran to Jesus as fast as he could. He fell at Jesus' feet, and cried, "My little daughter lieth at the point of death: I pray thee, come and lay thy hands on her, that she may be healed; and she shall live."

Jairus didn't care about all of his friends who were watching him. He didn't care that he might be put out of his church, or that he might not be popular anymore. His daughter was dying and he knew that Jesus could help!



When Jesus agreed to go to his house, Jairus must have felt much better. He knew the Lord Jesus was going to pray for his sick daughter, but there was still another challenge waiting for Jairus.

On the way to his house, a man came and told Jairus that it was too late, his daughter had already died. He told Jairus not to bother Jesus any longer, there was nothing He could do about it now. Jesus heard what was going on and encouraged Jairus. He said, "Be not afraid, only believe."

When they finally got to Jairus' house, everyone was crying and sad. Jesus looked at them and asked, "Why

make ye this ado, and weep? the damsel is not dead, but sleepeth."


The people who didn't believe Jesus knew the little girl was dead, but Jesus said that she was only sleeping! They laughed at Jesus, and thought He didn't know what He was talking about. Soon, they would discover it was *them* who didn't know what they were talking about!

Jesus told everyone to leave the room, except for the father and mother of the girl, and Peter, James and John. Then Jesus took the girl by the hand and said "Talitha cumi," which means "Damsel, I say unto thee, arise."

You already know what happened next. The little dead girl got up and walked! She was alive! Wouldn't you love to have seen the look on the unbelievers' faces when the little girl walked out of the room? Jesus proved once again that He was God in human flesh. It's summertime right now in this part of the world, and I'm writing a story for the Fall Cub Corner magazine.

Writing stories for the magazine is one of my favorite things to do here in YF.

Sometimes, before I get started, I like to take a break and clear my thoughts. So at break-time I left my office, walked down the hallway and stepped outside onto the VGR back dock. Everything was nice and green outside, and full of life. The warm sun and refreshing air was just what I needed. I looked down towards the VGR nature trail to see the beautiful trees and bright green leaves. They like to give off their shade when I take my afternoon walks down the trail.

This gave me a great idea of what to write about: "The Life of A Tree."

By the time you're reading this story, the season has already changed and things are a little

different. Step outside and look at the not-so-green grass, and notice the different kinds of leaves speckled on the ground. Now look up at the trees and see where those leaves are coming from, and tell me what color they are. They're changing, aren't they, but why? Why are they different colors and why are they starting to fall to the ground?

A leaf is like a life that lives off a big ole tree. In the springtime, the life from the tree travels from the roots, up the large trunk, through the branches, and out grows these big, bright, beautiful green leaves. All summer long they stay strong and green, and they give off their shade for the forest, and for people like me who like to walk in the forest. But as soon as August hits, their color and nature starts to change. The life from the tree begins to slowly move back into the branches. By the time September and October are here, the leaves are really starting to change colors and fall to the ground, because more and more life from the tree is somehow being pulled

back through the branches, down the trunk and into the roots, where it came from. Eventually, they lose their color and then fall to the ground, until the trees are completely bare. The tree looks dead, and any leaves that are left look brown and dead also. It seems kind of sad, but really it's not!

For a few months the weather will get real cold, and snow will fall in many parts of the world. This whole time the tree is holding it's life in the roots, waiting for the season when the sun will come back close again. By the time you build a few snowmen, sit in front of a few warm fires, and drink lots of hot chocolate, things will already be changing back. The snow will start melting, birds will be singing, and little colorful buds will start popping up at the ends of the tree branches. The tree seems to resurrect from the dead. What is it? Life! It's back! Up from the roots it comes, through the long branches and back into beautiful green leaves again. There is nothing that can keep the life of that tree from rising.

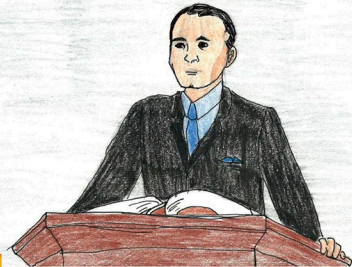
If we are borned again, we are a leaf on the Tree of Life. Even though we all might die someday, we will rise again, just like Jesus Christ did, Who will give us a new Life.

Brother Billy went to Brother Branham, and said "Daddy, you'll have to do something. That woman hasn't got a prayer card. And I give all those ushers orders not to let anyone in the prayer line without a prayer card." And said, "There she is down there; she's whipped every usher down there."

Brother Branham told Brother Moore to go down and pray for the baby, and maybe that'll comfort her. But no sooner than Brother Moore walked away and Brother Branham looked back over the audience, he saw a little Spanish baby sitting up, "going."



Brother Branham called for Brother Moore and had the woman come up to the platform. She didn't understand what he was saying, but he put his hand on the little baby and said, "God, Thou has showed a vision of this little Mexican baby. That mother's love has touched You in some way." 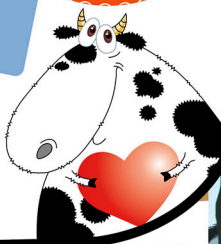


Holstein Cattle are famous for their black and white spots. They are almost always used as milk cows.

Cows make friends. Some cows make friends with certain cows and spend more time with them, while they seem to avoid other cows.



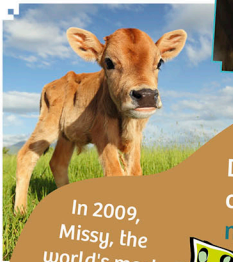
Cows have good sniffers. Experts believe that cows can smell things up to two miles away. On the other hand, a stinky cow can be smelled two miles away.

"HEALED BY THE LORD"

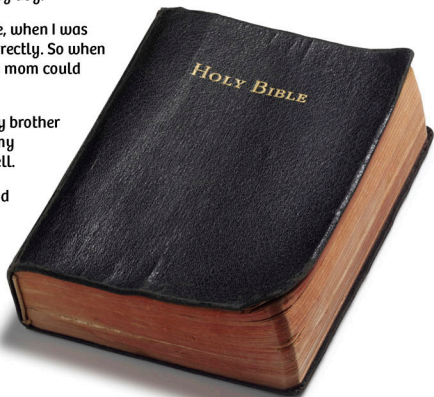
