So that next day or so, he was healed! That is the testimony of my little brother. Now he is 1 year old. I thank God for healing my little brother.



I am very fond of it. It has songs that Brother Branham used to sing at his meetings, stories he told and sermons he preached.


Well, I lost the charger, and my player was dead. I kept praying that I would find it again.


Isn't He wonderful? God takes His time. Dad helped me look for it, and oh joy, we found it! Thank You Jesus!

After Jesus died, Christianity started to grow and many people weren't happy about it. The followers of Jesus were in danger. People wanted them locked up in prison, or even killed!




