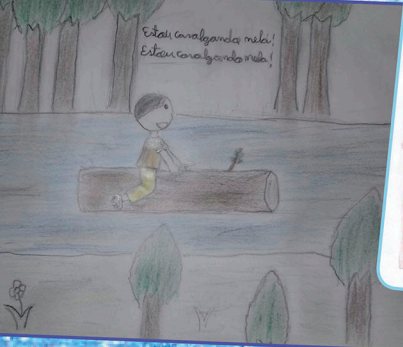
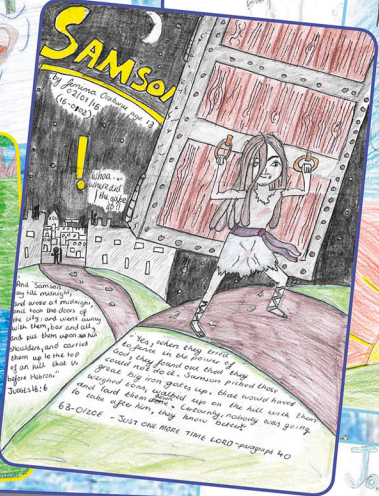
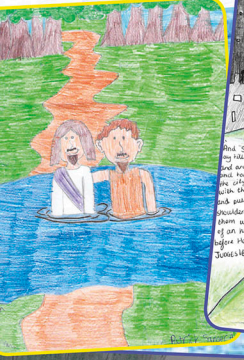

Who Am I?



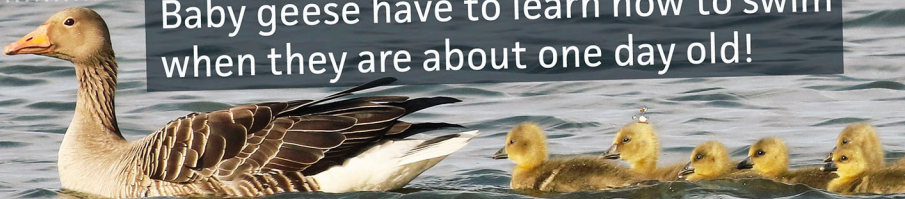


Baby geese!!!!

Baby geese are called goslings. A group of them is called a gaggle. That shouldn't be confused with a giggle, which is the sound they make when they laugh. Then you have a gosling giggle gaggle.

They are tiny now, but some geese weigh up to 15 pounds when they grow up. Goslings are also fast learners. They learn to fly approximately 2-3 months after hatching!

Baby geese have to learn how to swim when they are about one day old!

Geese can fly over 70% farther when flying in a V pattern.

SUPER-DUPER OREO AWESOME NESS
