## God Uses Prophets!

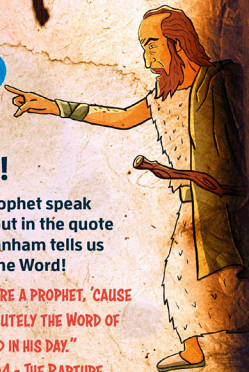

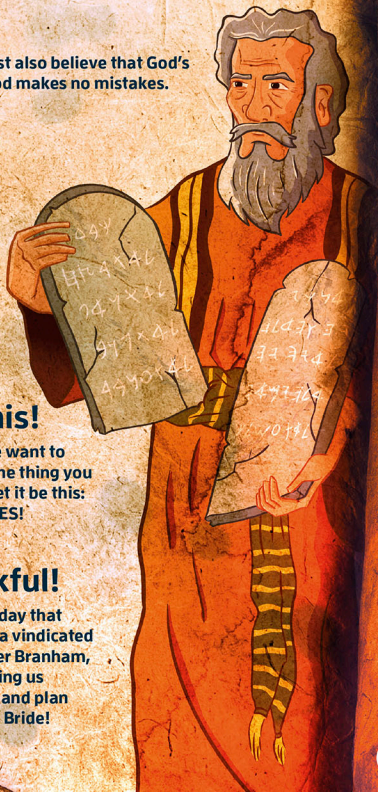
## No Mistakes!

We already said this, but we want to make sure you get it. If there is one thing you remember from this magazine, let it be this: God's prophets make **NO MISTAKES!**

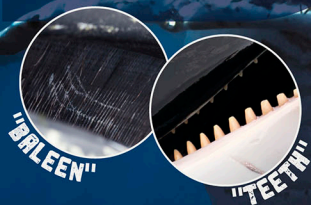
## We Are Thankful!

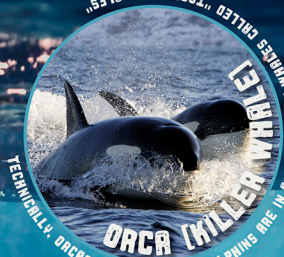
Blue whales have light colored skin, and if they stay at the surface of the water too long, they can get a sunburn!

**GOD ALWAYS HAS A PLAN**

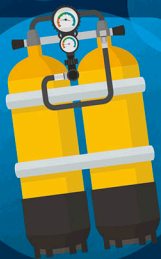

body, he'd walk up the creaky steps of their humble house and kneel down to pray.

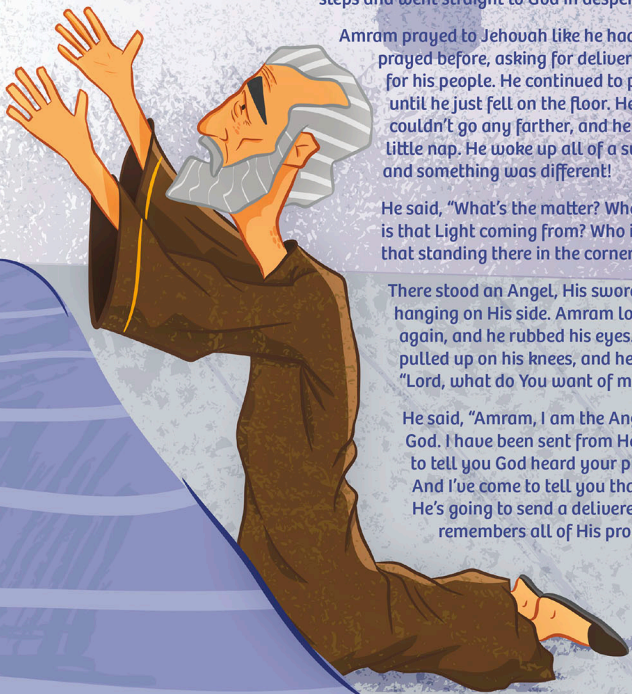

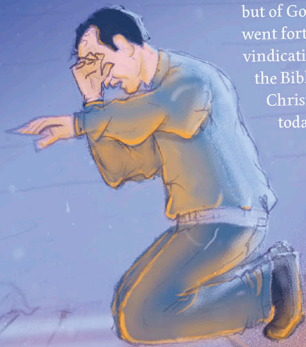

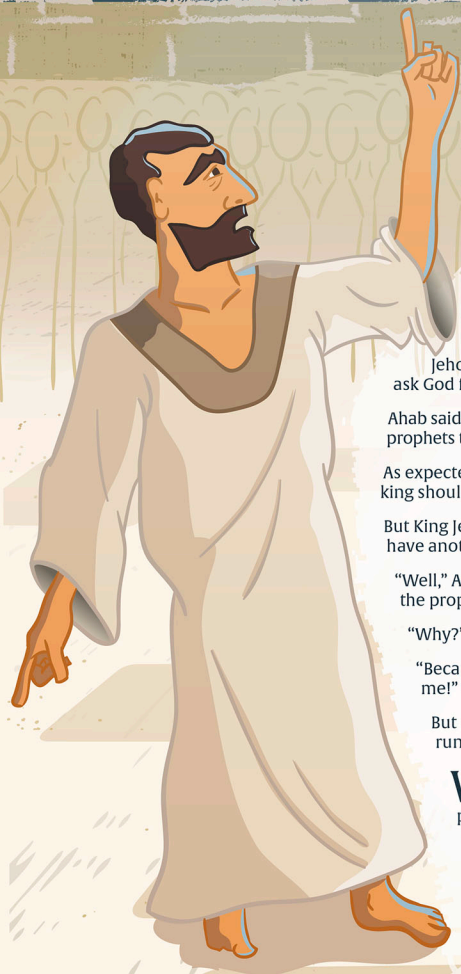

But that gallant prophet said, "As the Lord lives, I'll only say what God says!"

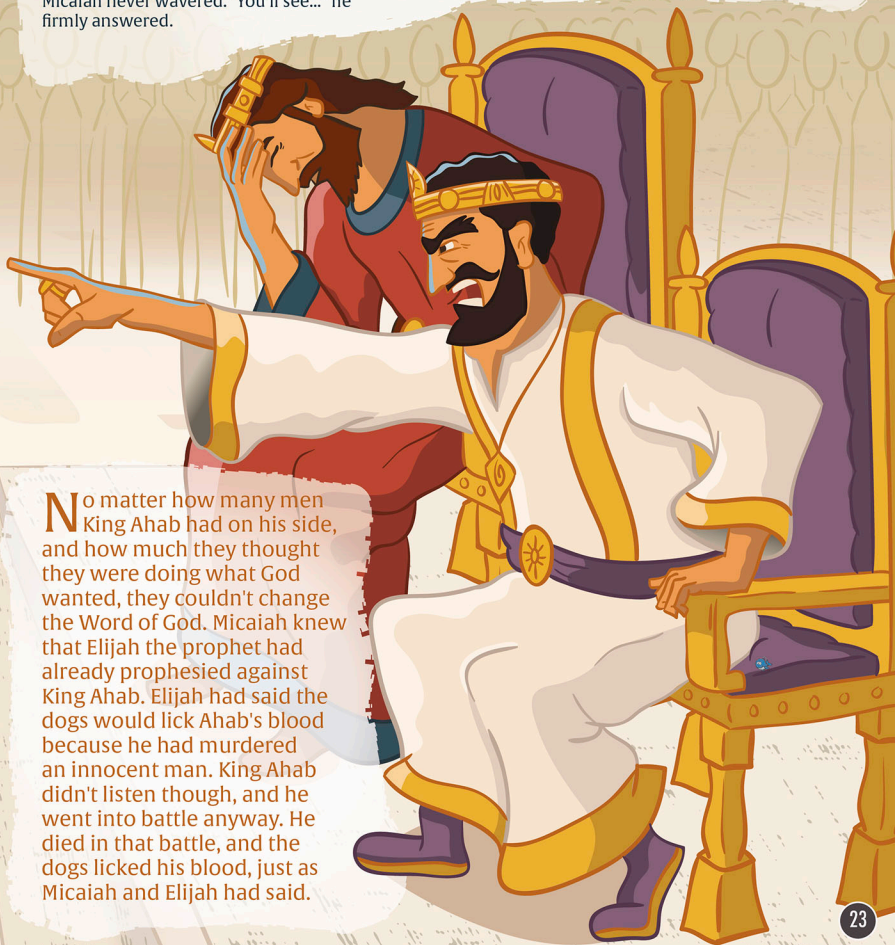
Later, as God's prophet stood before King Ahab, the king asked, "Well, Micaiah, shall I go up and take back our land, or not?"

Some people look to their church as an absolute. But how could a church be the absolute, when there

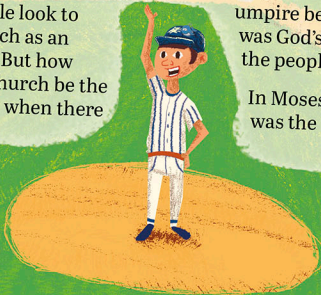
are hundreds of different churches, and each one has a different opinion?
